8	MATTERS ARISING					
8.1	Renovation of Auditorium Jasminben reported that the cost of renovation of auditorium would be in the vicinity of R1,75 million. The Scope of works included replacing ceilings, light fittings, windows and doors, floor finishes and painting of Auditorium. Jasminben reported that fundraising events are being organised to raise some funds.					
8.2	Migrate Marabastad Tenants to Debit Order system. Kalpanaben had reported that no progress has been made on obtaining a solution to the current Netcash system the Samaj has which does not allow for debit orders exceeding R1 600. This is because the Samaj has an NGO package. Harshadbhai was given a deadline to resolve the matter by June 2022.					
8.3	Upcoming events hosted by the Samaj Jasminben was appointed to oversee the planning of these celebrations. Planning of events in progress. Events include Bollywood Night planned for 14 May and Bhajan Mela on 29 May 2022, Gala Dinner in September, Samaj's 90th anniversary/cultural show.					

8.4 Samaj Legal Status

In a previous meeting, Rameshbhai had reported that the Samaj is at risk of losing its NGO and PBO status due to its rental income far exceeding its proceeds from donations. Although not present at the meeting, Rameshbhai reported that he had explained the matter to the trustees at the last trustee meeting where it was agreed that a special general meeting be held to obtain consent from the community on the way ahead.

8.5 **India's Liberation Heroes**

The President raised the issue of the Samaj not honouring all the liberation heroes of India. Harshadbhai reported that he has begun this process and will present about 10 potential candidates for Exco's consideration by the next meeting. Harshadbhai reported that the matter is still receiving attention.

8.6 *Maintenance Issues*

Vinaybhai reported that after several attempts he has received only one quote (Capital Roofing) thus far, for the renovation of the mandir dome and related damage. Vijaybhai stated that he is in the process of getting OUTsurance to pay for the expenses. They will be on site on Thursday for a decision.

It was resolved by exco, that in the light of urgency of the matter, the requirement for two quotes is waived by the executive. Vinaybhai is authorised to proceed with repairs by Monday 28 March if OUTsurance does not agree to the claim. Vijaybhai reported that OUTsurance had agreed to provide a formal response by 6 May 2022.

8.7 Contract with Designer Weddings

Rameshbhai reported that he had drawn up a new contract with Designer Weddings. This contract has been forwarded to Ahmed to sign and return. Rakeshbhai reported that Designer Weddings has signed the contract.

8.8 BALMANDIR COMPUTER CLASSES

Nayantaben requested clarification on how the Balmandir children will receive computer classes and if fees will be charged. It was agreed that each teacher would conduct their own computer classes with training from Rakesh, if needed. No fees will be charged on tuition. However, from next year a small surcharge will be added to Balmandir fees to help defray computer maintenance costs.

Rakeshbhai reported that he has trained the teachers on the use of the computers. Lessons will start as soon as the new MTN router (internet) has been installed.

8.9 **TEACHER PAYSLIP & EMIS NUMBER**

Nayantaben had previously informed members that the two Balmandir teachers registered with the department are no longer receiving payslips. Also, the department provides computer-based learning material for pre-schools that have an "Emis" number. As we do not have this number, we do not get any learning material from the Department.

Nayantaben reported we are awaiting a response from the Department of Education for an "Emis" number. In the interim, we have obtained permission from Laudium Primary school to use their number. In addition, the two registered teachers will have to go to the head office in Pretoria to do a yearly update so they can receive their payslips.

8.10	ONLINE GUJARATI CLASSES BY JAYSHRIBEN Jayshriben reported that she will start online classes every Saturday from 1 May.
8.11	CAMERA EQUIPMENT NEEDED Rakeshbhai requested that an HD 1040p Webcam with zooming facilities be purchased at a cost of R1 500. This would be used by the Sunday Mandir bhajan Group and for all other events streamed live from the mandir. Rakeshbhai was given the go-ahead to purchase the webcam from Vimalbhai.
8.12	UPGRADING OF WI-FI Rakeshbhai reported that there he is currently concluding an agreement with MTN for an upgraded WIFI system.
